

ASBESTOS AWARENESS SYLLABUS

Description: Training will inform workers on the hazards of asbestos including health risks, types of asbestos, exposures, and PEL levels. Information will also cover safe work practices, hazard communication, engineering controls, PPE and housekeeping practices.

Course start time: 7:30am – 4:00pm CBT Lab hours

Course Length: Approximately 25-40 minutes including test. (Course is 18 minutes in length)

Presentation Method: CBT – Computer Based Training

Audience: Any employees who will be working at a jobsite that contains or could contain asbestos.

Objectives: Upon completion of the course, trainees will have a general awareness knowledge of the following:

4. PPE
5. Use of hygiene facilities and practices
