

DRIVER SAFETY SYLLABUS

Description: Course is designed to provide trainees who will be operating vehicles at the job site with some basic rules and safety practices to follow. Most of the information will be like most state handbooks and any trainee that may have attended defensive driving.

Course start time: 7:30am – 4:pm CBT lab hours

Course Length: 30-40 Minutes including test (course is 20 minutes on computer)

Presentation Method: Computer Based Training (CBT)
