

SCAFFOLD USER SYLLABUS

Description: Training will inform workers on nature of hazards when working on or from scaffolds, fall hazards, proper use of handling of materials, load-carrying capacities, and pre shift inspections. Safe work practices will be address and scaffold tagging systems as well.

Course Length: Approximately 30-45 minutes including test. (Course is 23 minutes in length)

Presentation Method: CBT – Computer Based Training

5. Understanding scaffold tags
